The Academy Advisory Council (AAC) consists of staff, parents, local business and community representation. It is not, however, the same as a traditional governing body as it has no legal responsibilities. These responsibilities are held by the Greenwood Academy Trust (GAT) Board.

The Woodvale Primary Academy Advisory Council formally meets termly and all AAC members, particularly the chairperson, are encouraged to play an active part in the day to day life of the Academy.

The Council has three key roles in terms of the development and success of the Woodvale Primary Academy:

1. To advise and act as a critical friend to the Principal of the Academy and to advise the GAT Board of Directors about local issues they need to consider that affect the Academy.

2. To represent the interests of the Academy community in the running of the Academy and to represent the Academy in its community.

3. To provide support to the Principal in undertaking appropriate day to day procedures that are essential to the life of the Academy, such as disciplinary and complaint procedures.

The AAC are looking for two additional parents and two local business/community members, of which one of those members would be voted in as chairperson.
