Literacy (Talk for Writing Text: We're going on a bear hunt):-

This term we are learning:

- To retell a simple 5-part story.
- To answer comprehension questions linked to the story.
- To create a simple story map.
- To consider a story setting.
- To consider characters in the story.
- To consider story language.

Phonics:

s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, e, u, r, h, b, f, l.

Communication and Language:-

This term we are learning:

- To enjoy listening to longer stories and explain what happens.
- To learn and use a wider range of vocabulary.
- To understand a question or instruction.
- To use longer sentences of four to six words.

Maths:-

This term we are learning:

- Numbers to 5.
- Comparing groups within 5.
- Shape (2D and 3D shapes).

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:-

This term we are learning:

- To select and use activities and resources.
- To show more confidence in new social situations.
- To become more outgoing with unfamiliar people, in the safe context of the school environment.
- To increasingly follow the school rules.
- To remember rules without the adult needing to remind them.

Physical Development:-

This term we are learning:

- To continue to develop our ball skills.
- To choose the right resources to carry out a plan.
- To collaborate with others to manage large items.
- To use one handed tools and equipment.
- To show preference for a dominant hand.

Expressive Arts and Design:-

This term we are learning:

- To take part in simple pretend play.
- To explore different materials freely.
- To draw simple shapes and use these shapes to represent objects.
- To show different emotions in their drawings and paintings.
- To explore colour and colour mixing.

Home Learning:-

- Share a story every day.
- Ask your child to practise writing their name.
- Count objects around the house to 5.
- Go on a walk in your local environment and talk about the things you see.

The world (History, Geography and Science):-

This term we are learning:

- To know what a friend is.
- To know how friends help each other.
- To know how you can help someone who is feeling sad.
- To know where we live.
- To know what places we pass on the way to school.
- To know what places we like to visit.
- To explore the natural world using our senses.
- To recognise environments that are different to the one that we live in.
- To know who some of the key people are who help us to learn about our environment.
- To identify what I need to wear for each season.
- To describe what happens in Autumn.
