### Writing

Your job today is to design and **create a postcard** you could send to someone you haven't seen in a while. It could be addressed to your friends from school, your neighbour or a family member. You can chose the person you are going to write it to and then describe to them what you have done recently whilst learning from home and what you are planning to do next. Ask your parents to help you. Maybe they could show you some examples of postcards they have got or an online example.

#### Key features of a postcard:

The name and address of who you are sending it to.

Space in the top right hand corner for a stamp.

Space to write what you have been doing / plan to do this week.

A lovely picture to go with the postcard.

You could create your own postcard using your own materials such as colouring pens and card or you can use the blank template provided underneath.

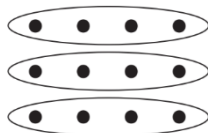
## Maths

*Multiplication – using arrays.*

In the home learning exercise books provided, your teachers would like you to complete the multiplication sentences using arrays.

Example;  $3 \times 4$  (3 groups of 4) = 12

### Curriculum Activity:

In Year 2, our topic learning was based on the 'COAST LINE' and we have been exploring the different points on a compass; North, East, South and West. To recap your previous learning on direction and compass points, your teachers would like you to play a game in your garden with someone you live with. Take it in turns to say the direction to the other player playing the game such as 'take 4 steps north' or 'take 6 steps west'. Once you have played this game there is also an online game you can play based on following directions using the points of a compass.
