Morning Job

Reading –

Read your favourite book you have at home and discuss with a family member:

What is your favourite part of the story and why?

Who is your favourite character and why?

Where was the story set?

Can you think of another ending for the story?

Phonics-

Activity 1: How many words can you think of using the 'AY' sound? For example; today. Can you write these down on a piece of paper and let your teacher know how many you could think of.

Activity 2: Practice writing the following words using your sound buttons (dots and dashes).

High, Sight, Snail, Whale, Shut, Floor

English – For your writing activity we would like you to go outside into your garden and use your senses to explore the environment:

What can you see?

What can you hear?

What can you smell?

What can you touch?

Now we would like you to write a range of sentences to describe your garden using **expanded noun phrases** (two adjectives before the noun) and **conjunctions** (linking sentences together).

For example: In my garden I could see some **small, grey birds** sitting on the fence **and** a **large, navy garden chair**.

Maths – Column Method (Addition only)

In the exercise books provided with your home learning pack or on a piece of paper can you please work out the following questions. We have done this in class before and you were all superb! We will start of slightly easier with no carrying underneath and then the questions will get slightly harder including carrying.

Remember, we always start with laying out our question with our tens and ones first. We start by adding the ones column first and then we move over to the tens column. Draw your circles to help you!

For example;

Carrying– We follow the same process, we start with the ones column and we draw our circles. When we need to carry under we write a 1 underneath the tens column . Next, we add up the tens column and don't forget to count in your carried 1 underneath the line and cross it off.

For example:
