Reading and Phonics- Bug Club Phonics

You should have recently received a letter regarding our online reading programme from Miss Hillyard. To access this you need to go onto [www.activelearnprimary.co.uk](http://www.activelearnprimary.co.uk) and enter in your child's login details using the following;

Username: Child's full forename (*capital letter for the first initial*) followed by the initial of their surname (*capital letter*) for example – JohnS

Password: Woodvalepri1

School code: p6gw

Your job today is to login and read one of your allocated books under the 'my stuff' area on the homepage. Before you read the book discuss with a family member;

- What can you see on the book cover?
- What do you think the book is going to be about?
- Do you think the book is likely to be fiction or non-fiction?
- From the front cover do you think there is a main character/s in the story?

Towards the end of the book there should be a quiz question which is a bug icon on the page. Once you have read and completed the quiz question, your finished book will move to 'My Library' and you will earn 'ActiveLearn Coins'. Your teacher will then receive a notification to allocate you some new books to read.

One day Charlie the Chick decided to have an adventure. When his mother was not looking and his brothers and sisters were asleep, he set off out of the farmyard gate.

Today you have the choice, you can either complete the following questions below in sentences or you can write a short story of what happens next. If you choose to write a story you need to include who Mother Hen meets on her journey and where does she finally find Charlie the Chick?

Don't forget to use expanded noun phrases to describe the different settings and characters. Your teacher will also be looking for capital letters, full stops and some adverbs to describe movement or sound (quickly or quietly).

1. What other animals does Mother Hen meet along her journey?
2. Where does Mother Hen find Charlie the Chick?
3. How does Mother Hen feel before and after she finds Charlie the Chick?
4. How does Charlie feel?

Maths – Learning Objective: To describe and create shape patterns

Today we are going to deliver the children's maths learning in a slightly different way. We are going to be using a website called '*Oak National Academy*' which offers individual lessons which are delivered to the students by a teacher using clips. It uses a step by step process and it is a great way to get the children involved in the learning of the lesson which is delivered similarly to how we would teach within our classrooms.

Before you start the lesson you will need a piece of paper and a pencil. When you first get onto the webpage you will need to click the button 'next activity' until your screen says 'Activity 2; Video'. Skip the video to 1 minute 36 seconds as that is where the learning begins. The video will take the children through a step by step process and is very easy to follow.

At 9 minutes and 15 seconds you may want to pause the video so your child can have a go at the main activity. You can then resume the video to view the answers for the main activity and to complete the lesson. Once you have completed the lesson you should click the 'next activity' button until the page says 'Activity 4: Quiz'. This is for the children to take part in a quiz independently to review the learning that has just taken place.
