
Here are some ambitious verbs you could put into sentences. Do you know what each word means? Can you include the word of the week in your writing?

The focus of the lesson is the ie sound. Maybe you could write some sentences of your own in your exercise book to practise words with the ie sound.


Maths

How many groups are there?


Use drawings to show the groups and write a **division** number sentence.
